**Feature Item – Zone 6 Championships in May and changes for seniors – Jim Collie**

We start that month off on May 8 with the Club Challenge event. Every golf club in Zone 6 has been invited to send a five-man team to compete in a scramble event. There are both gross and net team prizes which provide cash awards to the winners to further promote golf at their clubs. Make sure your club has entered. Our Zone 6 Amateur and Senior Amateur is set for May 29/30 at Morningstar. We will continue to use the same tees for both Amateur and Senior Amateur so that seniors may attempt to qualify for the BC Amateur. We will, however, use a separate set of tees for the 65+ flight. It is hoped that this will attract additional players in this bracket. We will award both gross and net prizes in both senior flights but players attempting to qualify for the BC Amateur or the Zone 6 Senior team must compete in the under 65 flight.
