



British Columbia Golf - Zone 6 Men
2022 Zone 6 BC Amateur and Qualifications
Storey Creek Golf Club
May 28 - 29, 2022

Eligibility: Open to all male amateurs who are active members of Member Clubs of the Zone 6 (including member of BC Players Club North Island Region). In addition to crowning our Zone Champion, this event will be used as a qualifier to select 11 participants for the 120th BC Amateur Championship, The Zone 6 Team will also be selected with this event. The top 4 finishers will be invited to play as part of our 4-man zone team. Each member of the zone team will be given \$300 each to go towards travel.

Note: *Amateurs who are not members of Member Clubs of Zone 6 are permitted to enter if they meet the handicap criteria and the field is not full; they will however not be eligible for Zone 6 Men Team and quota spots in the BC Amateur.*

Field: The Men's Amateur event will again be combined with the Zone Seniors and the total field will be limited to 64 players (estimated at 40 amateur and 24 senior positions). Should it be oversubscribed at the time entries close, each field will be reduced based upon lower handicap factors.

Event: 36 holes of stroke play. There will be gross prizes for the top 6-10 positions depending upon the size of the field. First tee start - @ 11:00 am each day.

Entry Fee: \$160.00 (includes lunch on May 29th). There is no additional qualifying fee for those wishing to play in the BC Amateur.

Entries: Friday May 20, 2022. Access to e-transfer on our website and we will accept emailed entry forms/signed waivers/handicap card. Mailed entries postmarked on that date will be accepted. No post entries. No telephone entries. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted. Refunds will not be issued after May 22, 2022. Send email entries to: michaeldcook@shaw.ca

BCGA ZONE 6 TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS AND WAIVER

- All competitors **MUST** be certified members of British Columbia Golf.
- **DRESS:** BCGA dress code to be adhered to during play and while on the golf course property during days of tournament: Full length slacks, plus fours, tailored rugby pants and tailored shorts (maximum distance six inches above kneecap.) Golf shirts must have collars and be worn inside slacks or shorts. Prohibited are jeans, sweatpants, tennis shorts, cut-offs, gym shorts and shirts with slogans, numbers and offensive illustrations. (Dress code applies to caddies also.)
- **CONDUCT:** Entrants are warned that conduct considered detrimental to the best interests of the game or unbecoming of a contestant, either on or off the course and coming to the attention of the Committee will be strictly dealt with and **MAY** result in disqualification of the offending person(s).
- **WITHDRAWALS:** A "withdrawal form" is available at the first tee or scoring table and must be completed by every competitor withdrawing during the course of the event. The reason given must be on medical or compassionate grounds acceptable to the Committee. Failure to provide an acceptable reason may result in automatic suspension of the privilege to play in all of next year's events sanctioned or conducted by Zone 6. A "no show" will be deemed an unauthorized withdrawal.

CONTESTANT WAIVER MUST BE SIGNED BY EACH PARTICIPANT IN CONSIDERATION OF BRITISH COLUMBIA GOLF ACCEPTING THIS ENTRY, AND INHERENT RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH THIS EVENT.

The applicant is aware of and assumes all risks of bodily injury or property damage, including specifically (but not exclusively) the risk of being injured by thrown or struck golf balls or clubs, actions by spectators, players, caddies, or others in attendance, and the competitor agrees that the British Columbia Golf Association, including its Directors, officers, employees and volunteers, as well as the competitors in the tournament, are not liable for any injuries or property damage resulting from such causes or any other negligence.
