Play is governed by the **Golf Canada Rules of Golf (effective January 2023)** and, where applicable, by the **Golf Canada 2023 Local Rules & Terms of The Competition** and by the following conditions, local rules and definitions.

Note: Ball Played as it lies

- 1. Tee Markers All players will play from the Red Tees 5197 yards
- 2. Unless otherwise provided, penalty for breach of a condition or Local Rule is two strokes.
- **3.** Lost or Out of Bounds please play a provisional ball and remember to announce it to the other players. The alternate to Lost or OB ball will **not** be in effect.
- **4. Pace of Play** the pace of play for this tournament is **4 hours.** It is incumbent upon you to police yourself as a foursome. Please keep up with the group in front of you.
- **5. Penalty Areas** are clearly marked.
- 6. The ball will be played down.
- 7. Flags marked as red front, white middle, blue back
- **8. Suspension of Play.** In the event of suspension of play for a dangerous situation (signaled by one long blast of an air horn), players must stop play immediately and head to the closest shelter.
- **9.** Ties will be determined by a count back.
- **10.** If you are in doubt about how to proceed, follow the 2 ball procedure for Stroke Play under Rule 20.1c (3). This must be reported to the Scoring Desk when returning your scorecard. If a player fails to report the playing of 2 balls, they will be disqualified.
- **11.** Washrooms are located at the 7th and 14th holes and port-a-potties are at the 5th and 14th holes.
