SECTION A: TERMS OF REFERENCE

This competition is governed by the 2023 R&A and USGA Rules of Golf where applicable, by the following terms and any Local Rules.

If in doubt as to procedure, invoke Rule 20.1c(3) Second Ball. Declare your intention to play a second ball, and prior to playing either ball state which ball you intend to score with if the rules permit, and obtain a ruling **BEFORE** signing your card, even if the score is the same for both balls. Penalty for breach of rule is disqualification.

Unless otherwise noted, penalty for breach of a local rule is a **TWO STROKE** penalty.

SECTION B: TERMS OF COMPETITION

All players will play from the green tees.

1. **CLOSE OF COMPETITION** - The Competition is deemed to have closed when the trophy has been presented to the winner or, in the absence of a prize ceremony, when all scores have been approved by the Committee.
2. **LOST OR OUT OF BOUNDS BALL** – Local rule E-5 alternative to stroke and distance for lost or out of bounds ball is in effect.
3. **PACE OF PLAY** - The "Zone 6 Pace of Play Policy 2019" is in effect.
4. **PENALTY AREAS** – marked with red stakes
5. **OUT OF BOUNDS** – marked with white stakes
6. **DISCONTINUANCE OF PLAY** – The course and all practice areas are closed when play is suspended for a dangerous situation until the Zone 6 Rules Committee has declared them open. A player using practice areas will be subject to disqualification.
Note: A suspension for a dangerous situation will be signalled by one prolonged air horn note. **ALL OTHER** types of suspensions will be signalled by three consecutive air horn notes. Resumption of play will be signalled by two short air horn notes.
7. **PRACTICE** – In stroke play competition, a player **may not** practice on or near the putting green of the hole last played or roll a ball on the putting green of the hole last played (see Rule 5.2b).
8. **RETURNING SCORE CARD**- A player's score card is deemed to have been returned to the Committee 15 minutes after the electronic score has been accepted into the scoring system and when the player has submitted the paper scorecard and completely exited the defined scoring area.

9. **TIES:** A tie for the winner in the Gross category will be broken by a playoff. All other ties will be determined in the following way:
- a. Gross score for last 9 holes minus one-half handicap; if still tied continue
 - b. Gross score for last 6 holes minus one-third handicap; if still tied continue
 - c. Gross score for last 3 holes minus one-sixth handicap; if still tied continue
 - d. Gross score for 18th hole minus one-eighteenth handicap

FAIRWAY MARKERS TO MIDDLE OF GREEN:

Gold 250, Blue 200, White 150, Red 100

FLAGS: All flags are yellow and black checkered. The position will be found on the pin sheet.

WASHROOMS:

Clubhouse, Hole #4 and Hole #13 near the tees.

Flight 1 Handicaps Hole #4
