NOTICE TO COMPETITORS (Champion of Champions, Pheasant Glen 2023)

Play is governed by the **Golf Canada Rules of Golf (effective January 2023)** and, where applicable, by the **Golf Canada 2023 Local Rules & Terms of The Competition** and by the following conditions, local rules and definitions. Complete text of Local Rules may be found in the Golf Canada Official Guide to the Rules of Golf (effective January 2023).

Note: Ball Played as it lies

- 1. Tee Markers All players will play from the Green Tees
- 2. Unless otherwise provided, penalty for breach of a condition or Local Rule is two strokes.
- 3. **Ball Lost or Ball out of Bounds: Model Local Rule E5, Alternative to Stroke and Distance** for Lost Ball or Out of Bounds: <u>will be allowed</u> for this competition.

This option allows the player to drop in a large area between the point where the ball is estimated to have come to rest or gone out of bounds and the edge of the fairway of the hole being played. This option cannot be used if a provisional ball has been played.

- 4. **Pace of Play.** The Pace of Play is governed by the British Columbia Golf Group Pace of Play Policy. **You are allowed 4 hours and 15 minutes for the championship.** It is incumbent upon you to police yourself as a foursome. Please keep up with the group in front of you.
- 5. Dropping Zones are located at Holes Number 9 and 13.
- 6. **Penalty Areas** are defined by red and yellow stakes. (Lateral relief is permitted in red staked penalty zones only.)
- 7. **No Play Zones.** Flower beds are No Play Zones. Free relief is permitted.
- 8. **Suspension of Play.** In the event of suspension of play for a dangerous situation (signaled by one long blast of an air horn), players must stop play immediately and head to the closest shelter.
- 9. Ties. Ties for Gross will be broken by a play off. Ties for Net will be broken by count back.
- 10. **Contacting a Referee**. The Referee assisting in this tournament is Gerry Gillis. If you require her assistance please call her at **250-202-6330**.

If you are unable to reach Gerry and are still in doubt about how to proceed, follow the 2 ball procedure for Stroke Play under Rule 20.1c (3). This must be reported to the Scoring Desk when returning your scorecard. If a player fails to report the playing of 2 balls, they will be disqualified.

TO SPEED UP SCORING AT THE END OF THE TOURNAMENT PLEASE PROCEED TO THE SCORING DESK IMMEDIATELY UPON COMPLETION OF YOUR ROUND AND PRIOR TO GOING TO YOUR CAR. Score cards must be signed by the marker and competitor.
