## NOTICE TO COMPETITORS (Champion of Champions, Nanaimo Golf Course 2025)

Play is governed by the Golf Canada Rules of Golf (effective January 2023). There will be a shotgun start at 9:00 am.

- 1. **Tee Markers** All players will play from the green/gold Tees.
- 2. Unless otherwise provided, penalty for breach of a condition or Local Rule is two strokes.
- **3.** Ball Lost or Ball out of Bounds: Model Local Rule E5, Alternative to Stroke and Distance for Lost Ball or Out of Bounds: will be allowed for this competition.
- This option allows the player to estimate the point where a lost ball has come to rest or gone out of bounds. From that point the player next determines the point on the fairway that is nearest that point. The ball may be dropped within two club lengths to the fairway side of the edge of the fairway. **This option cannot be used if a provisional ball has been played**.
- **4. Pace of Play.** The Pace of Play is governed by the British Columbia Golf Group Pace of Play Policy. **You are allowed 4 hours and 30 minutes for the championship.** Please keep up with the group in front of you. If times are exceeded and you are out of position, you will be issued with an official warning and may be liable to a penalty as applicable.
- 5. Penalty Areas are defined by red stakes. The wall on the water side of the right bunker on #9 is considered part of the penalty area penalty relief may be taken ball no closer to the hole.
- **6. Flags**: Front red; middle white; back blue
- **7. Out of Bounds** marked with white stakes or boundary fences.
- **8. Suspension of Play.** In the event of suspension of play for a dangerous situation (signaled by one long blast of an air horn), players must stop play immediately and head to the closest shelter.
- **9. Ties.** Ties for first place in the gross category will be broken by a play off. The first play off hole will be #18 followed by #10 then #18. All other ties will be determined by count back.
- **10. Contacting a Referee**. Referees assisting in this tournament Susie Youle and Gerry Gillis. If you require assistance call Susie at 250-327-8041.
  - If you are unable to reach a referee and are in doubt about how to proceed, follow the 2 ball procedure for Stroke Play under Rule 20.1c (3). This must be reported to the Scoring Desk when returning your scorecard. If a player fails to report the playing of 2 balls, they will be disqualified.

DESK IMMEDIATELY UPON COMPLETION OF YOUR ROUND AND PRIOR TO GOING TO YOUR CAR. Score cards must be signed by the marker and competitor.
