	☐ Numbers are submitted to BC Golf for audit. Takes about 2 months before they are submitted to the USGA.
	☐ USGA inputs these numbers into their database and sends new course rating and slope rating to the club. Both Golf and Golf Canada websites are updated.
	☐ Plan on at least 6 months before club gets the new ratings for scorecard revisions and scoring center.
