

## ZONE 6 T AND T REPORT FOR AGM

OCTOBER 15, 2018 – HELD AT EAGLECREST

Thank you for your participation in this season's Zone 6 events and thanks to Eaglecrest for coming to our rescue for the Champion of Champions event when Morningstar was unable to host. As Susie mentioned some of our tournaments this year were more challenging than others, weatherwise.

The Champion of Champions participation was up again this year as more clubs sent their Pin Day, Beat the Champ and DOF winners. The participation for the 4-Ball and the DCJ Amateur Senior was disappointing this year. The early bird prize of a free one-day entry to the Am Sen only drew five entries. Congrats to Dar Michell of Mount Brenton. At our last Executive meeting we decided to have the Amateur Senior as a one-day event in order to try to increase participation. We shall still offer the four-player team event.

Also to try to increase participation, we shall have first come/first served for registration rather than base it on levies. In order that this is fair for all clubs we shall open registration one month before each event, so if you have qualifiers at your club please adjust your schedule. Please note that there will be maximum numbers at each course – Qualicum 72, Alberni 120, Arrowsmith 92 and Eaglecrest \_\_\_\_\_, so please get your entries in as early as possible.

The gross and net club champions of each club, plus the Pin Day, DOF and Beat the Champ winners will be invited to attend the Champion of Champions event at Glacier Greens. There will be three separate

divisions: Gross, Net and Zone events with gross and net prizes in each division. Last year we had 15 entries in the Gross division, 15 in Net and 16 in Zone events.

The Amateur Senior will be a one-day event, open to players with a maximum handicap of 36.6. It includes a low net, four-person team event. We'd really like to see more than 70 players at this event.

The CTC is a three-person tournament, with the winners determined by combining the net scores of the three players.

The Net competition is for two partners and the format is net Stableford.

The 4-ball is for two partners, low combined net, and prizes are awarded to both gross and net winners. This year we shall not have the rather complicated registration restrictions we have had in the past. Clubs will send in their entries and prizes will be awarded in the Gross and Net categories to one third of the field.

A reminder that all of these events should be entered as tournament scores.

This year at the Captains' spring meeting we mentioned that we would have a participation award – each time a player entered a Zone event her name would be put into a hat. The prize is a free entry to any Zone event next season and the winner is **Carol Hastings of Alberni Golf Club**. (Name will be drawn at the meeting.)

The Zone Teams and Tournaments Spring budget anticipated a loss of \$300. Our actual loss was \$334, good budgeting by our financial guru Ann Lajoie.
