

ZONE 6 WOMEN'S GOLF 2020 TREASURER'S SPRING REPORT **See Note below*

I would like to welcome all of you to the 2020 Zone 6 Spring Meeting. I am Judy Aldcroft, Treasurer of Zone 6.

This year Zone 6 Ladies have a healthy budget of \$12,098.13. The increase over the last year's budget was due in part by the larger than expected funding from BC Golf (who bases their funding on the previous year's member number) and by lower than expected expenses.

A copy of the proposed budget is on the monitor and if all things go as proposed we will have a projected loss of \$1,385.50 by yearend 2020. This is due in part by the increased funding to Teams and Tournaments from \$2.50 per member to \$4.00 as agreed upon at the 2019 AGM and the purchase of a computer for our Teams and Tournaments group.

In your club envelopes you will find a letter from me explaining this year's Levies and a form to be filled out either by your Club administration or the Ladies Club. The levy is \$7.00 for each Business Lady, Woman Members and Junior Girls who have joined your clubs. Please have the form and the funds sent to me, at the address on the form, by the due date May 1, 2020. I will be sending out a second letter and form, to return to me by August 1st for members who have joined after May 1. **See Note below*

These funds help the Zone subsidize our Zone events Amateur/Senior, Champion of Champions, CTC, Net Tournament and 4 Ball. The funds also provide funding for Zone champions to travel to BC Championships and members who wish to take higher level rules courses will have some of their expenses covered.

Teams and Tournaments receive \$4.00 per member, of these funds to offset their costs and Junior Golf receives \$1,000.00 to help run their programs.

The remainder of the funds are used for general expenses, meeting, executive travel, office supplies and bank maintenance.

Without unforeseen large expenses we should still have a healthy balance for the remainder of 2020.
